## Scholarships for ISB students

Two students of the Indian School of Business (ISB) were awarded the newly-instituted Manyagroup-Princeton Review-**ISB** scholarships.

Amounting to Rs. 6.5 lakh, the scholarships are awarded to students who undergo GMAT training at Princeton Review centres administered by Manya Abroad and are enrolled for ISB's one-year post graduate programme in Management.

### Awardees

Goda Chandrasekhar and Samhita Das, currently pursuing the MBA programme at the institute, were awarded Rs. 1.5 lakh and Rs. 50,000 respectively at a disbursement ceremony organised at TPR centre in Hyderabad.

In all, 11 students who trained with our centres across the country have

made it to the ISB this year but two of them were eligible for the awards, said Araddhana K Mahna, managing director, Manya Abroad.

### Six scholarships
